She has recently co-produced a documentary comedy titled "The Truth About Film School" available VOD in North America and executive produced an indie musical in post production titled "NoWhere Fast" as well as several big budget films still in negotiation ranging from \$4 Million to \$30 Million in production budgets scheduled to be filmed in the USA, India and Europe.
